## Application for an award.

The Society is committed to encouraging archaeological research and has established this Trust to encourage students to undertake post-graduate studies (including Honours degrees) in archaeology or closely related fields, in topics with relevance to the Australian Capital Territory and region. The Student Prize is merit based and is awarded at the discretion of the panel established by the CAS Executive. ## Conditions of the CAS Student Prize

**The Trust has been established to provide financial assistance to those individuals who:**

- (a) are commencing or continuing relevant archaeological research undertaking post-graduate studies (including Honours degree);
- (b) are a current member of the Canberra Archaeological Society;
- (c) are Australian citizens or permanent residents within the meaning of the Australian Citizen Act 2007; and
- (d) excel at an Australian university in the study of archaeology or the conservation of archaeological cultural heritage within the Australian Capital Territory or surrounding NSW; or
- (e) are to embark upon a course of study in an Australian university that is, in the opinion of the Trustees, relevant to furthering the understanding of the archaeological history or cultural heritage of the Australian Capital Territory or surrounding NSW; and

**In receiving the Student Prize:**

- (a) acknowledgment of the support of the Canberra Archaeological Student Prize is expected all publications, reports, posters and theses arising from the research;
- (b) the recipient is required to provide a report summarising the outcomes of their research to be published with their name on the CAS website within one year of completing their research;
- (c) the awardee must present at the CAS Public Lectures within two years of receiving the funds;
- (d) the awardee may be asked to engage in future marketing for CAS



## Funding

These awards will be up to \$500 depending on the perceived relevance and scope of the project. A successful applicant may apply in subsequent years.

### **The Trustees may:**

- (a) Provide funds for the purchase of books or equipment;
- (b) Provide funds for travelling expenses;
- (c) Provide funds for the publishing the work of the recipient;
- (d) Provide cash prizes; and/or
- (e) Provide funds for any other purpose in the furtherance of the recipient's studies.

## Application process:

The Award is offered annually. Applications are invited from 10 February and must be received by 10 April. The successful applicants will be advised of the outcome by 10 May.
