## Application for grant.

The Society is committed to encouraging archaeological research and has established this Grant to encourage students and researchers to in archaeology or closely related fields to disseminate their research by publication or conference attendance. The Research Dissemination Grant is merit based and is awarded at the discretion of the panel established by the CAS Executive. ## Conditions of the CAS Research Dissemination Grant

**The Award has been established to provide financial assistance to those individuals who:**

1. Are Australian citizens or permanent residents within the meaning of the Australian Citizen Act 2007;
2. Are based in the Australian Capital Territory or surrounding NSW;
3. Are a current member of the Canberra Archaeological Society;
4. Are commencing or continuing relevant research in archaeology or the conservation of archaeological heritage; and
5. Require funding assistance for the dissemination of said research.

**In receiving the Research Dissemination Grant:**

1. Acknowledgement of the support of the Canberra Archaeological Research Dissemination Grant is expected for the associated presentation of the research; and
2. The awardee may be asked to present at CAS Public lectures, or another CAS affiliated event; and
3. The awardee may be asked to engage in future marketing.



## Funding

These grants will be up to \$300 awarded on a needs basis for research dissemination. A successful applicant may apply in subsequent years. If there are no suitable applicants in an application cycle, the trustees are not obliged to award the prize every year

### **The Trustees may:**

1. Provide funds for travelling expenses;
2. Provide funds for the publishing the work of the recipient;
3. Provide cash prizes; and/or
4. Provide funds for any other purpose in the furtherance of the recipient's research dissemination.

## Application Process

The grants are offered annually, more than one award each may be offered per year at the discretion of the trustees. Applications are invited from 31 March and must be received by 31 May. Successful applicants will be notified by 30 June.
